If you wish to be a person entitled to claim in the class action and you had a commercial loan, you do not need to do anything at this time.

If you wish to "opt Out" of the class action, (meaning that you do not want to participate in it), you should get legal advice and you can do so by filling in an opt out notice available from Hall Partners, and posting it to the Sydney Court Registry, Supreme Court of New South Wales on the form enclosed, and / or by emailing it to the Sydney Registry of the Supreme Court of New South Wales, supreme_court@courts.nsw.gov.au

We otherwise wish you a better new year than the years 2008 through to 2012 may have been for you, if you were subject of action on your loan by BankWest in those years and we look forward to hearing from you, assuming that this email finds you at your proper email address, after all these years.
